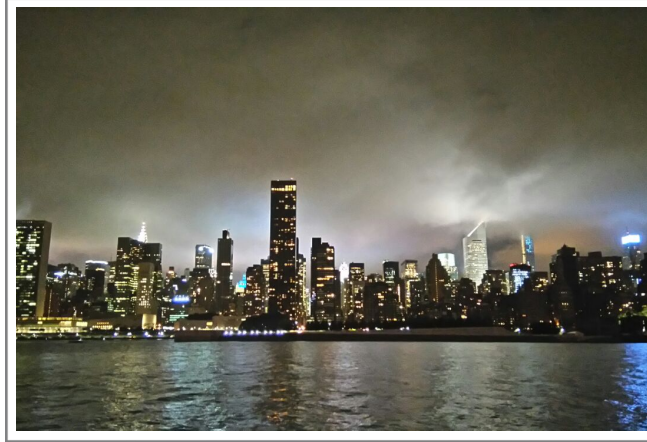


2026 Application & Donation Requirements



Global Peacemakers Program - New York City

Program Dates: June 11 - June 26, 2026

Thank you for your interest in the Global Peacemaker's Program - NYC. All application material should be sent via email and within a folder to headquarters@kinderenergy.org. Application deadline is March 15 2026. If you are applying from the EU. If you missed the deadline, please contact us.

Application Requirements: (All material must be in English)

1. Application Form (can be found on website: <http://kinderenergy.org/united-nations>. **Application fee is a \$50.00 non refundable donation to Kinderenergy.**
2. 1 page CV of student (should include past employment and language abilities).
3. Motivation letter of no more than one page long stating: a.) why you think children are important for the environment and b.) how your participation in this program will benefit Kinderenergy.
4. 2 Letters of recommendation (written in English or Spanish by someone other than family).
5. Proof of medical insurance while in the USA.
6. Total donation requested to participate in the Global Peacemakers' Program in NYC is \$1300 (paid via donation site online). All donations will go to support Kinderenergy and its educational projects in Tanzania, India and Cambodia. Kinderenergy is a 501c3. All donations are tax deductible in the USA.
7. If you would like Kinderenergy to book you housing accommodation, please let us know ASAP.

Acceptance into Program

If you are accepted into the program, 50% of donation cost must be sent in to hold your place within approximately one week of acceptance into program or by March 7, 2026. Failure to do that will forfeit your spot and another person on the waiting list will be chosen.

When budgeting for trip to NY, add cost of accommodations (\$1500), train travel costs to either Harvard or Princeton University round trip flight, meals, travel insurance or transportation once in NY. All applications will be considered but the program is only limited to 10 students.**
